

Greetings from Bassenheim, Germany we pray this letter finds you and your ministry blessed and strengthened by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. God has been very good to us as we serve Him here in Germany. We want to thank you for praying for us and faithfully financially supporting us also.

My family and I were recently in the States for two weeks. My father celebrated his 60th birthday. It has been almost a decade since we have celebrated a birthday together. It was nice to see our siblings and family in Texas and New Mexico. The last time we were in the States was almost three years ago. I am thankful that Nicole's family and my family live in the same area.

Our two weeks in the States was spent attending two missions conferences and preaching at my home church in El Paso, Texas. On the 30th of September I had the great privilege of preaching at my sending church on my dad's birthday. I want to thank Hillcrest Baptist Church for loving on us during our time there. I love my home church and our Pastor. It was nice to see so many new faces amongst the faces I have seen since my childhood. God is doing great things at Hillcrest Baptist Church. The next 3 days I was in Alamogordo, NM at the Berean Independent Baptist Church with Pastor K.R. Senn. Berean Baptist Church is my second home away from home. We enjoyed preaching by Dr. Alverson.
